

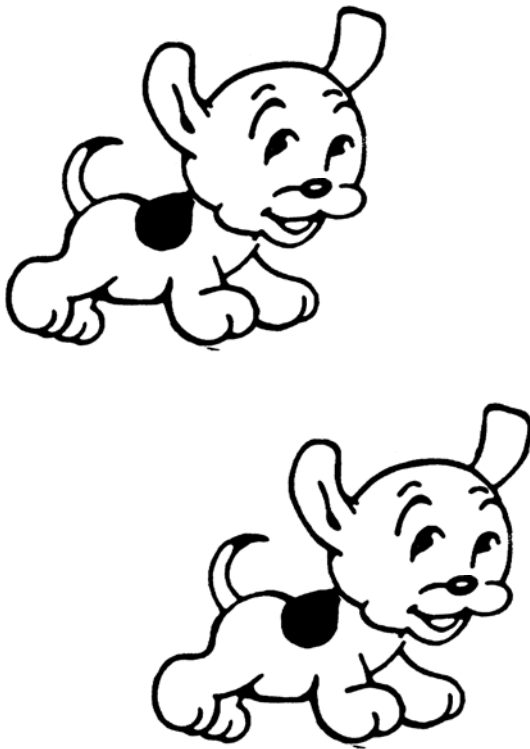

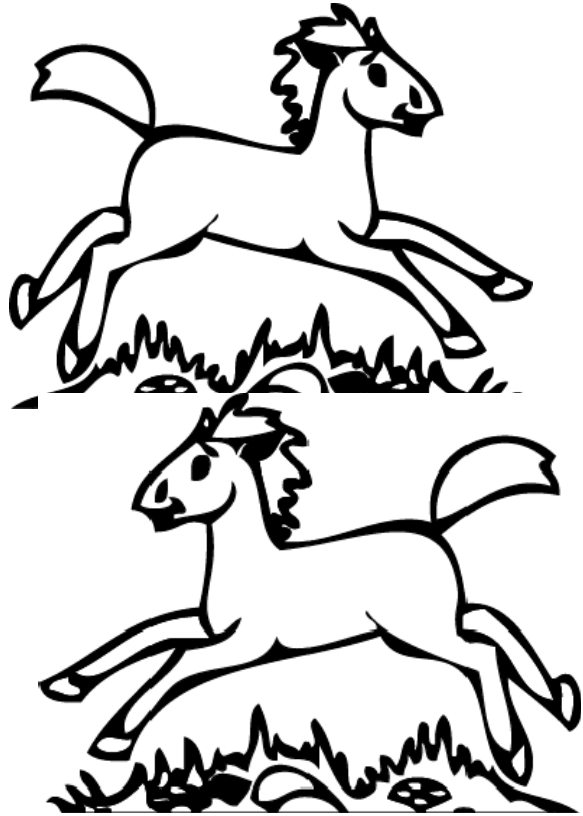

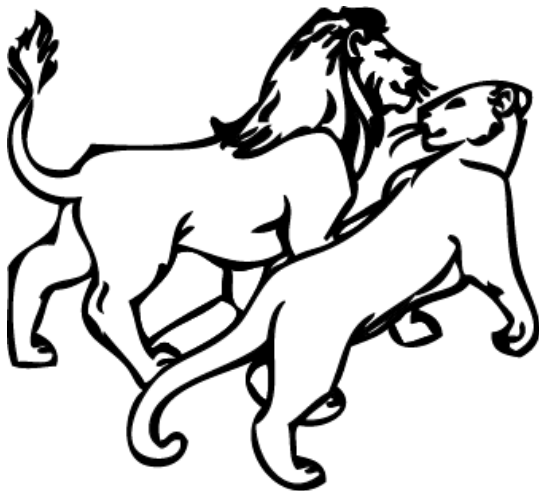
The Jews, in the Old Testament, did

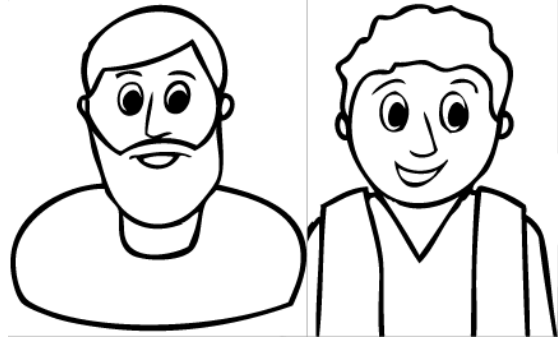
